TEAM MANAGER MEETING

The Manager's Meeting will be held at the Little Harbor Cay – Radisson House Manor Lobby – Upstairs at **9:00pm** on **Wednesday, August 4, 2010**.

TRANSPORTATION

Shuttle busses will operate between the hotels (Radisson and Reef Village) and the Lucayan Country Club according to the schedule posted on the Notice Board. Schedules vary according to date and we ask that you consult the Notice Board regularly.

TEE TIMES

Tee Times will be posted as soon as they are available on the Notice Boards and on the tournament website www.cajgc2010.com.

MEALS

All meals from Tuesday, August 3-8 at the hotel are included with the tournament. Breakfast and Dinner will be served buffet style in the **Barracuda Restaurant**. Please consult the Notice Board for directions. Lunch will be served at the Golf Course. Meal tickets for Lunch are included in the tournament package for the **Team Managers**. Please ensure that your team members have their lunch tickets as they will **NOT** be served without them.

PRACTICE RANGE

The Practice Range will be opened from 6:30 a.m. until 7:00 pm each day. Each Team has an assigned spot on the Range and team members are expected to use only their assigned spots.

OPENING CEREMONY

The Opening Ceremony will be held in the **Convention Center – Salons 4 & 5** on Wednesday at 5:30 pm. Team photographs will be taken at 3:30 pm at the Great Lawn. Please ensure that your team is ready to be photographed as soon as they arrive at the Great Lawn.

Bags will be stored at the Golf Club immediately behind the Clubhouse. Only bags that have the tournament tag will be accepted for the storage container.

BAG CARRIERS

Bag carriers are provided for the 13 & Under GIRLS ONLY. Assignment will be done through the Tournament Committee Office.

PULL CARTS

Pull carts will be available to those who may wish to use them.

ON COURSE WATER & FOOD

Each Team will be provided with a daily supply of bottled water and snacks. Team Managers are asked to collect these from the Club House by 7:30 am each morning. Limited supplies of additional water and Gatorade are available on the course.
