BAHAMAS

Devaughn Robinson

Bahamas: Devaughn is a senior attending Texas Southern University in Houston, Texas majoring in Drafting and Design Technology. Throughout his collegiate golf career, he has consistently played within the top two positions on his golf team. Involved with the sport for 10 years, he has won two NCAA tournaments, including the South Western Athletic Championships and the Texas Southern Tiger Invitational. He has also earned spots on four Bahamas Junior National Teams, the 2008 and 2009 Hoerman Cup Teams, and is now playing in his first Caribbean Cup.

Benjamin Davis Jr.

Bahamas: Currently 15 years old, Ben was introduced to golf some 11 years ago, and became a Bahamas Junior National Team member for 7 consecutive years. He attends the IMG Academies in Bradenton, Florida. His pursuits in golf have earned him a runner-up finish in the 2009 IMG DLGA Open, 3 top tens on the Future Collegians World Tour, and top individual performance honours at the 2009 CAJGC in Jamaica.

Oren Butler (Captain's Pick) Bahamas: Oren is a senior at the University Of South Carolina - Beaufort, where he is majoring in Business Management and Marketing. As a collegiate golfer, he is strongly amongst the team's top 3 players, and has accomplished two top 2 tournament finishes. His performance propelled the team to its first victory at the Webber Invitational. He was introduced to golf at the age of 13, and became a member of Bahamas National Teams as a Junior three times and a CAGC Hoerman Cup player 3 times. He was also a member of the winning West Team of the 2007 Caribbean Cup in Puerto Rico.
